



### Hazardous Materials Security Rule HM-232

The Research and Special Programs Administration (RSPA) has issued a rule which will implement security requirements for the transportation of certain hazardous materials. The components of the Security Plan are as follows:

- **Personnel Security** – Measures in place to confirm information supplied from job applicants hired to handle hazardous materials that remain within the confines of applicable federal and state employment practices and individual privacy.
- **Unauthorized Access** – Measures in place to address assessed risks of an unauthorized individual gaining access to hazardous materials or transport conveyances being prepared for transportation.
- **Enroute Security** – Measures in place to assess risks surrounding the shipment of hazardous materials from origin to destination, including shipments stored incidental to movement.
